Dear Neighbour,

IMPROVEMENT WORK – Plantation Road Footbridge, Ferriby

I am writing to inform you that Network Rail needs to undertake necessary repairs to the Yorkshire Wolds Way footbridge over the railway near to your property as part of our strategy to deliver a better railway for Britain.

This work is safety critical and will include repairs and repainting to the metalwork, repairs to the concrete kerbs along the bridge, and replacing the entire wooden deck with new boards and anti-slip strips.

It will be necessary to close the Yorkshire Wolds Way footpath from 14 January until 29 March 2019, which has been agreed with the local authority.

In order to carry out this work we will be using diesel generators, a pressure washer, lighting tower, compressor, air tools, drills, grinders, cut off saws, chain saws, a mobile tower scaffold, telehandler and road vehicles to transport plant and materials to site.

Work will be undertaken at the following times:


